R.5883 :- Standard of Passing :

The term end examination is for 2 hours duration and for maximum 50 marks. For the Purpose of results, the marks will be converted out of 40 marks per term. Individual passing in project with 7 marks out of 20 is compulsory. However, the marks scored in theory and project together be taken as one head of passing in the subject.

In case of failure in project work, the student has to re-submit the Project individually and appear for the viva-voce. In case of failure in theory, the student has to appear for theory exams - (100 marks to be converted out of 80 marks)-held in subsequent years. In such cases, the marks secured earlier under the project head will be carried forward for a further period of maximum three academic years only.

Further that in exercise of powers conferred upon the Management Council Under Section 55(1) of the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994, it has made the Regulation 5883 relating to the Standard of Passing in the subject of Foundation Course Paper I at the F.Y.B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. examinations and the same has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2007 - 2008.

Those of the successful candidates who secure 60% or more of the total marks of their final year examination (Sem.VII & Sem.VIII) of 4 year Bachelor of Engineering Degree Programme within one more chance to succeeding the year of completion of their course work and examination taken together will be deemed to have passed the final year of B.E. degree examination in First Class.

In regular course three more additional attempts in succeeding examination for Sem.VII and Four more additional attempts in succeeding examinations for Sem.VIII.

Those of the successful candidates who secure 50% or more of the total marks of their final year examination (Sem.VII & Sem.VIII) of 4 year Bachelor of Engineering Degree Programme within one more chance to succeeding the year of completion of their course work and examination taken together will be deemed to have passed the final year of B.E. degree examination in Second Class.

In regular course three more additional attempts in succeeding examination for Sem.VII and one more chance to succeeding examinations for Sem.VIII.
