CIRCULAR:-

Attention of the Head, University Department of Law and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in the Faculty of Law is hereby invited to the Ordinance, Regulations and syllabi relating to the LL.M. degree course (By Papers) vide pamphlet No.46 and this office Circular No.UG/358 of 2003, dated 28th July, 2003 and they are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Board of studies in Law at its meeting held on 13th August, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 8th October, 2004 vide Item No.4.1 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 29th October, 2004 vide item No.22 and that in accordance therewith the following Regulations relating to the class improvement for the LL.M. degree (Old Course) has been passed:-

R. 4853 :- Candidates who has passed the LL.M. degree examination under the old course with class mentioned in Column 1 and who desires to improve his/her class or percentage as shown in Column 2, below will be permitted, at their option, to appear again for the same group's examination with each of the groups without being required to keep any fresh terms :-

Column 1

Column 2

Second Class

At least 55% marks or First Class

If a candidate who re-appears for the LL.M. degree examination under the old course under this Regulation, fails to improve his/her class, or percentage, his/her performance at such re-appearance will be ignored.

If a candidate appears under this provision, he/she should appear in the group separately within two consecutive examinations i.e. one group in April and the other group in October.

Further that the aforesaid new Ordinance will be brought into force with effect from the examination to be held in the Second Half of 2004 :-
