Sir,

I am to invite your attention to this office circular No.UG/ 27 of 2002 dated 15th January, 2002 and to inform you that the following recommendation made by the Ad-hoc Committee appointed by the Academic Council to advise it on all matters relating to the courses of study and examinations leading to the degree of B. Sc. (Aviation) at its meeting held on 13th September, 2005 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 28th December, 2005 vide item No.4.13 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 18th February, 2006 vide item No. 3 and that in accordance therewith Regulations 4482, 4483, 4487, 4488, 4492 and 4493 relating to the standard of passing for the First Year B. Sc. Second Year B. Sc. and Third Year B. Sc. (Aviation) degree examinations is amended to read as under:-

Standard of passing at the First Year B. Sc. (Aviation) Examination

R.4482 :- To pass the First Year examination, a candidate must obtained a minimum of 35% marks in each theory subject/s and practical/s, separately.

R.4483 :- An unsuccessful candidate who secure 35% marks in theory subject/s or practical/s he/she will be granted exemption for appearing the theory/practical subjects.

Standard of passing at the Second Year B. Sc. (Aviation) Examination

R.4487 :- To pass the Second Year examination, a candidate must obtained a minimum of 35% marks in each theory subject/s and practical/s separately.

R.4488 :- An unsuccessful candidate who secure 35% marks in theory subject/s or practical/s he/she will be granted exemption for appearing the theory/practical subjects.

Standard of passing at the Third Year B. Sc. (Aviation) Examination

R.4492 :- To pass the Third Year examination, a candidate must obtained a minimum of 35% marks in each theory subject/s and practical/s, separately.

R.4493 :- The class will be awarded as under :-

The candidate obtained 60% marks be shown as First Class.

The candidate obtained 45% marks be shown as Second Class.

The candidate obtained 35% marks be shown as Pass Class.

Further that the amended Regulations 4482, 4483, 4487, 4488, 4492 and 4493 relating to the standard of passing for the First Year B. Sc., Second Year B. Sc. and Third Year B. Sc. (Aviation) degree examinations are made effective from the examination to be held in the first half of 2006.
