CIRCULAR :

Attention of the Deans of the affiliated Medical colleges is invited to the Ordinances and Regulations relating to the Diploma in Orthopaedics vide this office Circular No.UG/191 of 2004 dated 21st May, 2004 and No.UG/265 of 2004 dated 25th June, 2004 respectively and they are hereby informed that the following recommendation made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Surgery and Allied subject at its meeting held on 23rd July, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 7th August, 2004 vide item No.4.13 and has subsequently been approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 13th August, 2004 vide item No.6 and that in accordance therewith the Ordinance 5430 relating to the eligibility conditions prescribed for admission to the Diploma in Orthopaedics and Regulation 4764 relating to the Period of Training & Eligibility for registering Diploma in Orthopaedic Examination has been amended to read as under :-

O.5430 :-Eligibility for Registration

Every candidate for Registration to the graduate diploma course in Orthopaedics shall have complied with the conditions hereunder :-

- (a) The candidate should have passed the examination for the graduate degree of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery of this University or any other University recognized by MCI as equivalent thereto.
- (b) Completed such period of examination pre-degree compulsory housemanship or internship or rotating internship which entitled him to the award of the degree Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery required by and to the satisfaction of this University where applicable.
- (c) The Post-graduate student in the Faculty of Medicine will not be permitted to register simultaneously for Diploma and degree courses of this University or of any other University or any other college e.g. C.P.S. Bombay. He may however take up examination of National Board of Examination.

Further that R.4764 relating to the Period of Training & Eligibility for registering Diploma in Orthopaedic Examination has been amended to read as under :-

R-4764 - Period of Training and Eligibility for registering for Diploma in Orthopaedic Examination:-

The period of training shall be two years i.e. four academic terms after registration as Post-graduate student.

For registering for the final examination the necessary documents should be submitted by the candidate testifying to his having held an appointment as a Resident Orthopaedic at a hospital recognized by this University for the purpose for a period of at least 24 months.

Further that amended Ordinance 5-430 and Regulation 4764 has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2004-2005.
