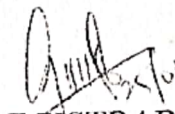

Examination Pattern of Revised syllabus of Post Graduate Diploma in Special Education (Multiple Disabilities: Physical and Neurological)

R 5767. PERIODIC EVALUATION AND FINAL EXAMINATION

(a) Scheme of Examination

1. Examination for the Post Graduate Diploma in Special Education (Multiple Disabilities: Physical and Neurological) shall consist of

PART A- Theory- Assessment as per R1

PART B- Practical- Internal Assessment as per R2

2. A candidate for the examination in parts A and B must apply for examination through the principal/head of the college/ institution in which he/ she is receiving training.

3. i) The Part B shall be evaluated as per R. 2. The institution shall forward to the University the marks awarded to every candidate in Part B1, B2 and B3.

ii) Internal Evaluation Marks for Part A papers would be submitted to the University with the marks of B1 and B2 of Part B at the end of the academic year.

4. i) A candidate who has kept terms for the P. G. Diploma in Special Education (Multiple Disabilities: Physical and Neurological) examination but who has either not appeared for Part A or failed in Part A, will be permitted at his option to carry forward the marks obtained in Part B to three subsequent examinations.

ii) A candidate who has passed in Part A but fails in Part B will be permitted at his option to carry forward the marks obtained in Part A to three subsequent examinations. Annual final examination will be held for Part A, B1 and B2 of Part B. Internship will be held after completion of the academic year.

iii) A candidate who fails in a particular paper shall be allowed to reappear in that theory paper/s. However his/ her marks of internal evaluation for that paper/s would be carried forward.

5. The practical- internal assessment of B1 and B2 would be evenly spread over one academic year. The Practical-internal assessment B 3 would be completed after completion of the academic year.

6. Structure of the Post Graduate Diploma in Special Education (Multiple Disabilities: Physical and Neurological) syllabus will comprise of Part A- Theory- Assessment and Part B- Practical- Internal Assessment as follows

(b) Minimum Passing marks /percentage/grade

A percentage of 40 and above in theory and 50 and above in practical examinations will be considered as pass.
An overall percentage of 45 and above will be considered as pass.

An overall percentage of 50 and above will be considered as pass with 2nd division.

An overall percentage of 60 and above will be considered as pass with 1st division.

An overall percentage of 70 and above will be considered as pass with 1st division with distinction.

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
