

CIRCULAR:-

Attention of Principals of the affiliated colleges in the Faculty of Arts, Science and Commerce is hereby invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the Bachelor of Hotel and Tourism Management Studies (B.H.T.M.S) degree course vide pamphlet No.339 and they are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Bachelor of Hotel and Tourism Management Studies (B.H.T.M.S.) at its meeting held on 24th September, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 14th December, 2004 vide item No. 4.5 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 21st December, 2004 vide item No.13 and that in accordance therewith the Ordinance 5101 relating to the Eligibility Criteria for admission to the Bachelor of Hotel and Tourism Management Studies degree course has been amended to read as under :-

O.5101 : Eligibility

- A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Degree Course in Hotel and Tourism Management shall have to pass XII Standard Examination of any State Board or its equivalent and secured not less than 50% marks in the aggregate (**45% marks in the case of Backward Class candidates**)
- Every candidate admitted to the Degree Course in the Affiliated College/ Recognized Institution conducting the course, shall have to enroll himself/ herself with the University.
- A candidate who has already passed his/her Three Year Diploma in Hotel Management from any recognized Board in India or abroad, he/she will be admitted directly to the Third Year of the B.H.T.M.S. course to facilitate him/her to convert his/her Diploma into Degree.

Further that the amended Ordinance 5101 will be brought into force with effect from the academic year 2005-2006.
