1. If candidate is failed in Applied Physics-I OR Applied Chemistry – I OR both has to appear and pass in the subject Applied Sciences-I of Semester –I of Revised Scheme (R-2001). The highest Term Work marks be carried over.
2. If candidate is failed in Applied Physics-II OR Applied Chemistry-II OR both has to appear and pass in the subject Applied Sciences-II of Semester II of Revised Scheme (R-2001). The highest Term Work marks be carried over.

3. If candidate is failed in Basic Electricity & Electronics - I OR Basic Electricity & Electronics-II OR both has to appear and pass in the subject Basic Electrical & Electronics Engineering of Semester - I of Revised Scheme (R-2001). The highest Term Work marks be carried over.
4. If candidate is failed in Engineering Mechanics-I OR Engineering Mechanics-II OR both has to appear and pass in the subject Engineering Mechanics of semester I of revised Scheme (R-2001). The highest Term Work marks be carried over.
5. If candidate is failed in Engineering drawing-I OR Engineering Drawing-II OR both has to appear and pass in the subject Engineering Drawing of Semester II of Revised Scheme (R-2001). The highest Term Work marks be carried over.
6. If candidate is failed in Communication Skills - I OR Communication Skills-II OR both has to appear and pass in the subject Communication Skills of semester II of revised Scheme (R-2001). The highest Term Work marks be carried over.
7. The statement of marks of the Revised Scheme will be issued to the Candidates mentioning the "Conversion of Old Scheme to Revised Scheme".
