Regulations and Syllabi relating to the Bachelor of Architecture degree course (B.Arch.) vide Pamphlet No.165 and to this office Circular No.UG 103 of 2001 dated 28th March, 2001 and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in Architectures are hereby informed that the following recommendation made by the Ad-hoe Board of Studies in Architecture at its meeting held on 30^{dt} July, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 7th August, 2004 vide item No.4.11 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 13th August 2004 vide item No.6 and that in accordance therewith. the Ordinance 5002 relating to the eligibility criteria prescribed for admission to the First Year of the B.Arch. Degree Course has been amended to read as under :-

0.5002 : A candidate for being eligible for admission to the First Year of the B.Arch. Degree Course :-

Must have passed the HSC (Std. XII) Examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with English and Mathematics as subjects at HSC or its equivalent examination.

The candidate must have secured minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for backward class category candidates from Maharashtra State only) in the HSC (Std, XII) or its equivalent examination.

In addition, the candidate must have passed the aptitude test 11) conducted by the competent authority to be eligible for admission to the B.Arch. Degree Course.

Further that the amended Ordinance 5002 has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2004-2005.
