A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabi relating to the LL.M. degree course vide Pamphlet No. 46 and to this office Circular No.UG/356 of 2003 dated 28th July, 2003 and the Head, University Department of Law and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in Law are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Board of Studies in Law at its meeting held on 6th June, 2008 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 13th June, 2008 vide Item No.4.35 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 27th June, 2008 vide Item No.13 and that, in accordance therewith, the amended Ordinances 5239 and 5240 relating to the eligibility for admission to the LL.M.(Semester III & IV) degree course to read as under :-

O.5239 :- A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Third and Fourth Semester must have either passed in the First and Second Semesters or must have got exemption in at least six papers of the First and Second Semesters.

O.5240 :- Unless students passed all the practical papers of three semester examination and dissertation of the Fourth Semester, their final result shall not be declared.

Further, that in exercise of powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 54(1) of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994, it has amended Ordinances 5239 and 5240 relating to the eligibility for admission to the LL.M (Semester. III & IV) degree course and that same has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2008-2009.
