## CIRCULAR:-

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the LL.B. degree course (Three Years and Five Years Degree Course) vide Pamphlet No.44 and to this office Circular No.UG 368 of 2001 dated 20th October 2001 and the Head. University Department of Law and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in Law are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the joint meeting of the Board of Studies in Law and the Principal of Law Colleges held on 16th July, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 7th August, 2004 <u>vide</u> item No.4.10 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 13th August 2004 vide item No.6 and that in accordance therewith. the Regulation 4437 relating to the standard of passing for the LL.B. degree course (Three Year and Five Year) has been amended to read as under :--

> R- 4437: To pass the examination the candidate must obtain 45% of the full marks in each paper's and practical's. Those of the successful candidates who obtain 45% marks in each paper's and practical's at one and the same examination will be placed in the Second Class. Those of the successful candidates who obtain 60% marks of the total of the aggregate at one and same examination will be placed in the First Class.

> A candidate who obtains 50% marks in each paper's and practical/s may, at his option, be exempted from appearing in the paper/s and practical/s.

Further that the amended Regulation 4437 has been brought into force with effect from the examinations hald in the Second Half of the year 2004
