CIRCULAR :

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabi relating to the LL.B. degree course (three years and five years degree course) vide pamphlet No.44 and to this office Circulars No.UG/368 of 2001 dated 20th October, 2001 and No.UG/199 of 2003 dated 19th May, 2003 and No.UG/298 of 2004 dated 20th July, 2004 and the Head, University Department of Law and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in Law are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the faculty of Law and the Board of Studies in Law at its joint meeting held on 12th January, 2005 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 5th February, 2005 vide item No.4.4 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 18th February, 2005 vide item No.6 and that in accordance therewith the Regulation 4853 relating to the class improvement for the LL.B. degree course (Three-Year and Five-Year) is passed to read as under :-

R.4853 : Candidate who has passed the LL.B. degree (Three year and five year) examination under the old course or revised course with class mentioned in Column I and who desires to improve his/her class or percentage as shown in Column II, below will be permitted, at his/her option, to appear again for the examination without being required to keep any fresh term/s :-

Column - I

Pass Class

Second Class

Column - II

Second class/First class

Atleast 55% marks

OR

First Class

If a candidate who re-appears for the LL.B. degree (Three Year and Five Year) examination under the old course/revised course under this Regulation fails to improve his/her class or percentage, his/her performance at such re-appearance will be ignored.

If a candidate appears under this Regulation, he/she should appear in all the papers at one and the same sitting.

Further that the aforesaid new Regulation 4853 will be brought into force with effect from the examination to be held in the first half of the year 2005.
