CIRCULAR :

Attention of Principals of the affiliated colleges in the faculty of Law is hereby invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the LL.M. degree course (by papers) vide Pamphlet No. 46 and to this office Circular No.UG-353 of 2003 dated 8th July, 2003 and they are hereby informed that the following recommendations made by the Board of Studies in Law at its meeting held on 13th August, 2004 has been approved by the Ag. Vice-chancellor on behalf of the Academic Council under the powers conferred upon him under Section 14(7) of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994 is as under :-

"Candidate who has passed the LL.M. degree examination under the old course with class mentioned in Column 1 and who desire to improve his/her class or percentage as shown in Column 2, below will be permitted at his/her option, to appear again for the same groups examination with the each of the group without being require to keep any fresh terms:-

Column 1

Column 2

Second Class

At least 55% marks or
First Class

If candidate who re-appear for the LL.M. degree examination under the old course under this provision, fails to improve his/her class, or percentage, his/her performance at such re-appearance will be ignored.

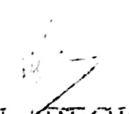
If candidate appears under this provision, he/she should appear in the group separately within two consecutive examinations i.e. one group in April and other group in October examination.

The above recommendation brought into force with effect from the examination to be held in the Second Half of 2004."

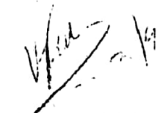
