Attention of the Head, University Department of Sanskrit and Principals of the affiliated colleges in the Faculty of Arts and the Director, Institute of Distance Education is hereby invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the Master of Arts (M.A.) degree course vide Pamphlet No.157 to this office Circular Nos. UG/70 of 1995 dated 15th February, 1995, No.UG/76 of 1999 dated 23rd February, 1999 and UG/189 of 2002 dated 2nd May, 2002, respectively and they are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Board of Studies in Sanskrit, Pali and Prakrits at its meeting held on 7th April, 2004 and 24th August, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 8th October, 2004 vide item No. 4.18 and that in accordance therewith the patterns of question papers for Paper I – Prose and Paper III – Grammar and Translation at the M.A. Part-I examination and Paper II – Poetry in the subject of Pali at the M.A. Part-II examination has been revised as under :-

Paper-I-Prose-M.A. Part-I

(Marks-100)

Q.1 Translate any one from each group

Three groups of passages (from 3 prescribed texts), containing two passages in each group are to be asked.

Q.2 a) RTC Two out of Four

(Marks 12)

b) RTC Two out of Four

(Marks 10)

Q3. Write critical notes on any four out of six

(Marks 20)

Two topics from each prescribed text are to be asked.

Q.4 A general question - on the prescribed texts.

(Marks 20)

Q.5 A general question – on the prescribed texts.

(Marks 20)

Paper III-Grammar and Translation-M.A. Part-I

(Marks 100)

The weightage of marks to the questions in Paper-III at M.A. Part-I examination in the subject of Pali, is as under :-

Q.1. - Marks 20

Q.2 – Marks 20

Q.2. - Marks 40

(Note :- The paper pattern and marking system for Papers V and VII at the M.A. Part-I examination in the subject of Pali remain the same.)

Paper II – Poetry M.A. Part-II

- Q.1 Translate any two from group A and any Two From group B.
Three passages are to be given in each group (Marks 20)
- Q.2 Explain with reference to the context any two from each group. Four lines are to be given in each group. (Marks 20)
- Q.3. Paragraphs – 2 out of four. (Marks 20)
- Q.4. General Questions (Marks 20)
- (Note.- The pattern of the question-Papers for Papers-IV, VI and VIII in the subject of Pali at M.A. Part-II examination remains the same.)

Further that the revised pattern has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2004-2005.
