Attention of the Head, University Department of Sanskrit and Principals of the affiliated colleges in the Faculty of Arts and the Director, Institute of Distance Education is hereby invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the Master of Arts (M.A.) degree course vide Pamphlet No.157 and to this office Circular No.UG/189 of 2002 dated 2nd May, 2002 and they are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Board of Studies in Sanskrit, Pali and Prakrits at its meeting held on 7th April and 24th August, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 8th October, 2004 vide item No. 4.17 and that in accordance therewith the pattern of question paper for Paper VII – Study of Classical Poetry and Prose in the subject of Sanskrit at the M.A. (Part-I) examination has been revised as under :-

- Q.1. Translate and annotate any two groups of the following:- (Marks 20)
Three groups (containing two stanza is each) are to be asked.
- Q.2. Explain fully any three of the following (5 sentences are to asked)
(Marks 15)
- Q.3. General question with internal option
(Marks 15)

Section II

(Marks 50)

- Q.4 a) Translate and annotate any two of the following :- (Marks 20)
Three passages are to be asked.
- b) Explain fully any two of the following (4 sentences are to be asked)
(Marks 14)
- Q.5 A general question or two paragraphs out of four are to be written.
(Marks 16)

(Note :- The paper-pattern for Papers I, III and V at M.A. Part I in the subject of Sanskrit remains the same.

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The paper-pattern for the Papers II, IV, VI and VIII at the M.A. Part-II in the subject of Sanskrit remains the same.

Further that the revised paper-pattern has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2004-2005.
