Attention of the Deans of Medical colleges is hereby invited to this office Circular No.UG/197 of 2002 dated 6th May, 2002 and they are hereby informed that as per the notification issued by the Government of India vide letter No. MCI-26(3)2003-med/ 21005 dated 16th October, 2003 regarding maximum permissible attempt and period of passing the First M.B.,B.S. examination waived for October, 2003, the Director of Medical Education, Government of Maharashtra Vide its G.R. No. संकीर्ण-२१०४/२८५/प्र. क. ४०/०४/शिक्षण ३ dated 27th July, 2004 are quoted below :-

"पारंपारिक विद्यापीठांमध्ये १९९८ पर्यन्त असलेला वैद्यक विद्याशाखेचा अभ्यासक्रम व त्याचा कालावधी व महाराष्ट्र आरोग्य विज्ञान विद्यापीठांमध्ये असलेला अभ्यासक्रम व त्याचा कालावधी भिन्न आहे, यामुळे तसेच महाराष्ट्र आरोग्य विज्ञान विद्यापीठ अधिनियम, १९९८ कलम १४ (अ) नुसार असलेली तरतुद विचारात घेता, महाराष्ट्र आरोग्य विज्ञान विद्यापीठ अस्तित्वात येण्यापूर्वी ज्या विद्यार्थ्यांनी पारंपारिक विद्यापीठांकडे आरोग्य विज्ञान अभ्यासक्रमासाठी नोंदणी केली आहे, त्या विद्यार्थ्यांच्या परीक्षा ते विद्यार्थी पदवी प्राप्त करीपर्यंत पारंपारिक विद्यापीठांनी घेणे आवश्यक आहे यास्तव या परिपत्रकान्वये शासन असे आदेश देत आहे की, १९९८ पूर्वी आरोग्य विज्ञान अभ्यासक्रमासाठी पारंपारिक विद्यापीठांकडे नोंदणी केलेल्या विद्यार्थ्यांच्या परीक्षा ते विद्यार्थी पदवी संपादन करीपर्यंत पारंपारिक विद्यापीठांनी घ्याव्यात."

The Ag. Vice-chancellor in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under Section 14(7) of the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994 has accepted the amendment mentioned in the said G.R. on behalf of the Academic Council.

They are therefore informed that the examination for the first M.B.,B.S. will be held under the existing syllabus of the University with immediate effect i.e. second half of the 2004 and thereafter.
