Sir,

I am to invite your attention to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabus relating to the Master of Chemical Engineering and Master of Technology degree course vide Pamphlet No. 189 and to inform you that the recommendation made by the Board of Studies in Chemical Technology at its meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> December, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2004 vide item No.4.39 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2004 vide item No. 13 and that in accordance therewith notwithstanding the provisions contained in Regulations 4131 and 4132 relating to the M.Chem Engineering degree course and Regulation 4195 relating to the M.Tech. Degree course the following provisions has been made applicable in the case of students appearing for the repeat examinations, including the subject 'Elective' at the M.Chem. and M.Tech. degree course:-

1. Students who are appearing for repeat examination of M.Chem. Engg. And M.Tech. degree course be permitted to take their previous elective subjects for repeat examination.
2. The first repeat examination of M.Chem. Engg./M.Tech.(Sem-II) shall be held in January, 2005. This repeat examination shall be specially for those who had appeared in May, 2004. Thus, the University letter No.UG/493 of 2004 dated 17<sup>th</sup> November, 2004 is made applicable for the M.Chem. Engg./M.Tech. (Semester-II) examination held in May, 2004. The other examinations will be as mentioned in the said circular.

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3. If a candidate fails in the 'Seminar' Head or fails to appear for the 'Seminar' presentation, at the M.Chem. Enggg./M.Tech. examination and if he/she opts for a topic other than the one earlier given, he/she shall not be eligible to appear for the corresponding repeat examination. Such candidates shall be permitted to appear for the subsequent regular examination with the changed seminar topic. Appearing at a repeat examination shall be optional.
4. In Chemical Technology Management course the Term Work marks shall be carried over to subsequent examination. However such candidates shall not be eligible for class in the said examination.
