Attention of the Head, University Department of Commerce, Principals of the affiliated colleges in the faculty of commerce and Professor-cum-Director, Institute of Distance Education is hereby invited to this office Circular No.UG/389 of 2003 dated 7th August 2003 relating to the Master of Commerce (E-Commerce) degree course and they are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Board of Studies in commerce at its meeting held on 2nd August 2006 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 18th August 2006 vide item No.4.19 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 15th September 2006 vide item No.13 and that in accordance therewith, Ordinance 5211 relating to the eligibility criteria prescribed for the M.Com. (E-Commerce) degree course is amended to read as under:-

0.5211:- A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Master of E-Commerce degree course shall have passed B.Com. examination OR B.Com. (Accounting and Finance) OR B.Com. (Banking and Insurance) OR B.M.S OR B.Sc. (I.T.) OR B.Sc. (Computer Science) OR B.Sc. (Mathematics) OR B.Sc. (Statistics) OR B.M.M. degree examinations of this University and secured not less than 50% marks at one and the same sitting (45% in case of reserved category) OR any other equivalent examination of other recognized University.

Further that the amended Ordinance 5211 relating to the eligibility criteria prescribed for the M.Com.(E-Commerce) degree course has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2006-2007.
