

CIRCULAR :-

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabi, relating to the M.E. (Part-Time) degree Course vide this office Circular No.UG/281 of 2001, dated 17th August,2001 and Pamphlet No.190 and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in Engineering are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Faculty of Technology at its meeting held on 26th March,2008 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 15th April,2008 vide Item No.4.47 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 24th April, 2008 vide Item No.16 and that in accordance therewith, the Ordinance 5057 relating to the eligibility criteria for the M.E. degree (P.T.D.C.) has been amended to read as under :-

O.5057 : Any candidate who has passed an examination for the degree of Bachelor of Engineering/Technology of this University OR the degree of Bachelor of Engineering/Technology of any other University recognized and equivalent to the Bachelor of Engineering/Technology Degree of this University with 55% marks (50% of marks in the case of Backward Class candidates). (The reservation policy be followed as per Maharashtra State Government Higher & Technical Education Department (शासन निर्णय क्रमांक टीईएम १०/००/१८८/००) ता.शि.१, दिनांक १ जुलै, २०००) Notification dated 1st July 2000) is deemed to be eligible for admission to the Master's degree course in Engineering (PTDC) in the specific branch in which he has taken the degree of Bachelor of Engineering of a related branch as listed below :-
