No.20 and as under :-

R 4283: Three copies of the dessertation shall be submitted by the students Kazo Head of the Institution where he/she is registered, before the commencement of the M.P.Ed. Part-II theory examination. A candidate, who fails to submit his/her dissertation before the commencement of the M.P.Ed. Part-II theory examination will be allowed to appear for theory examination that year. The results of the candidates who submit the dissertation later than the commencement of the M.P.Ed. Part-II theory examination will be declared as and when he/she gets through the viva-voce and such candidates will not be eligible for a class. The dissertation when submitted shall be accompanied by a certificate signed by the guiding teacher as well as Head of the Institution stating that the same is the candidates own work carried out under his guidance and supervision and is worthy of examination.

The Head of the Institution will forward two copies of each dissertation received from the candidate before the commencement of the M.P.Ed. Part-II theory examination to the Examination Section.

The amended Regulation 4283 relating to the M.P.Ed. degree course has been made by the Management Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon it under Section 55(1) of the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994 and that the same will be brought into force with effect from the first half of the year 2007.
