

CIRCULAR:-

Attention of Deans of the affiliated Medical College and the Director, Ali Yavar Jung, National Institute for the Hearing Handicapped is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the (M.P.Th. & M.O.Th.) **Pamphlet No.34 and 35** respectively and to this office Circular No.UG/353 of 2002 dated 20th August, 2002 and they are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Ad-hoc Committee appointed by the Academic Council to advise it on all matters relating to the courses of study and examinations leading to the degree of Master of Occupational Therapy (M.O.Th.) (Speciality) at its meeting held on 17th February, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 2nd April, 2004 vide item No.4.70 and that in accordance therewith the pattern of written and practical examinations and guidelines for paper-setters and for conduct of practical examination for the students of the M.O.Th. course admitted in March, 2003 and August, 2003 in the academic year 2002-2003 will be as under :-

WRITTEN

- 1) There shall be five written papers each of three hours duration.
- 2) Paper-I shall include general conditions, cardio respiratory conditions, musculoskeletal disorders and rheumatology.
- 3) Paper-II shall include condition related to Neurosciences, developmental disabilities and mental health.
- 4) Paper-III shall be in the subject of Advanced Practice issues in Occupational Therapy.

Note :- Paper I, II and III shall be common papers to all specialties

- 5) Paper IV and V shall be based on specialties subjects.

PATTERN OF PAPER SETTING :-

- 1) Paper I, II and III shall include total four questions, out of which any three questions are to be attempted. One of the four question shall include three short notes out of which any two are to be attempted.
- 2) Paper IV shall include total two essay type questions based on respective speciality, out of which any one question is to be attempted.
- 3) Paper V shall include total three questions based on respective specialty out of which any two questions are to be attempted.

CLINICALS

Clinical (1) and (2) shall include two cases, one case from conditions mentioned in Paper I and one case from conditions mentioned in Paper II. Emphasis shall be given on appropriate clinical reasoning and Occupational Therapy intervention. Clinical III shall include one long case based on respective speciality. Clinical IV shall include one short case based on respective speciality.

Clinical III and IV :- Emphasis shall be given to the ability to do functional diagnosis with appropriate clinical reasoning for Occupational Therapy intervention.

Viva-voce shall include the following :-

- A) Spots to include orthoses, prostheses, adapted equipment's and Wheelchair adaptations.
- B) Microteaching
- C) Investigations viva (to include spots)
- D) Dissertation viva.

Further, that the guidelines for declaration of results and preparation of Mark list and Certificates is as follows :-

Methods of Assessment in the examination at M.O.Th. :- Points shall be granted per examinations i.e. in Theory, Clinical/viva etc. in the following pattern :
