Attention of the Principals of the affiliated Colleges in the faculty of Science the Head of the recognized institutions concerned is hereby invited to the notices, Regulations and syllabi relating to the Master of Science (M.Sc.) examination vide pamphlet No.175 and to this office Circular No.UG/303 of dated 20th July, 2002 and they are hereby informed that the following recommendations made by the Board of Studies in Bio-chemistry at its meeting on 10th December, 2003 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 3rd January, 2004 vide item No.4.28 and has been subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 28th January, 2004 item No.22 in exercise of the powers conferred upon it under sub-section (1) of section 54 of the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994 and that in accordance with **O 2445** relating to the eligibility criteria prescribed for admission to the M.Sc. (By Research) in Bio-Chemistry be amended to read as under and that the same has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2003-2004:-

O 2445: A person who has passed the Bachelor of Science examination in a subject at least in the Second Class of this University or of another University recognized as equivalent thereto shall be eligible for admission to the degree of Master of Science (by Research) in that subject.

In case of the subject like Biochemistry, the eligibility criteria applied for the admission to M.Sc. degree (By Papers) as per the O.2441 shall also be applicable for the admission to M.Sc. degree (By Research) in Biochemistry.

Further that the candidate who has passed his/her B.Sc. examination at least in the Second class of this University with Three or Six units at T.Y.B.Sc. in Microbiology, Life Sciences, Biotechnology, Botany, Zoology or any other Biological Sciences, or the degree equivalent thereto of other University in one of these subjects as a major principal subject, shall be eligible for admission to M.Sc. degree (By Research) only in the subject of Biochemistry.
