

CIRCULAR:-

Attention of the Directors of recognized Institutions enrolling the students for M.C.A. degree course is hereby invited to the Ordinances relating to the admission for the Master of Computer Application (M.C.A.) degree course vide pamphlet No.194 and to this office Circular No.UG.383 of 2004, dated 3rd September,2004 and they are hereby informed that the proposal for amendment of Ordinance 2645 relating the eligibility criteria prescribed for admission to the Master of Computer Application (M.C.A. Degree Course) has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 8th October,2004 vide item No.4.21 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 29th October,2004 vide item No 22 and that in accordance therewith, the O.2645 has been amended as under :-

"O.2645. A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Master of Computer Application (M.C.A.) Degree Course must have passed with minimum 45% marks in aggregate (40% in case of backward class candidates from Maharashtra State only) in any Bachelor's degree of minimum three years duration in any discipline recognized by the Association of Indian Universities and having studied Mathematics or Statistics as one of the subjects at 10+2 level or higher level examination".

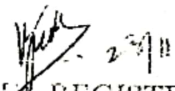
Further that the amended O. 2645 has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2004-2005.

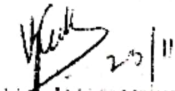
