Sir,

I am to invite your attention to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the Master of Theatre Arts Degree vide Pamphlet No.349 and to inform you that the recommendation made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Theatre Arts at its meeting held On 5th October, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 8th October, 2004 vide item No.4.26 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 29th October, 2004 vide item No.22 and that in accordance therewith the Ordinance 5247 relating to the eligibility criteria and Regulation 4365 relating to standard of passing for the Master of Theatre Arts Degree course has been amended to read as under :-

O.5247. Eligibility

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Master of Theatre Arts shall have passed the Graduate examination in any stream from the University of Mumbai or equivalent.

OR

Degree in Dramatics and Theatre Arts from any recognised University.

AND

Entrance examination/Interview, audition and aptitude test.(theory and practical.)

R.4365. Standard of Passing

1) Theory : 40% marks be required for passing.

2) Practical, Internal Assessment and Project Work 50% marks be required for passing.

O.5247. Eligibility

3) Internal Assessment and Project Works marks be carried over for award of a class.

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Master of Theatre Arts shall have passed the Graduate examination in any stream from the University of

4) If candidate fails in any one Theory paper and in any one Practical be considered for ATKT in first Year.

- 5) The class should be awarded at the Final Year only taking into consideration the marks of the First Year and the Second Year taken together.
 - 6) Candidate claiming exemption in any Theory or Practical examination at the First Year or the Second Year will be eligible for award of class but not for claiming any rank or medal.
 - 7) If candidates fail up to two subjects for the Second Year they can reappear for that subject as ex-student. If candidates fail in more than two subjects, they will have to reappear for all the examinations for not more than three attempts.
 - 8) The 90% attendance is required to appear for the examination.
 - 9) Regular students are not allowed to seek or accept any engagements to appear in public either on the amateur or professionals stage or in any Radio or T.V. programmes, films or undertake outside employment during the term of their study.
- Further that the amended Ordinance 5247 and Regulation 4365 has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2003-2004.
