**Ordinances and regulations relating to the
One Year Course in Conversational Japanese
(New course beginning in the academic year 2009-10)**

The University Department of German offers a Certificate Course, a Diploma Course, and an Advanced Diploma in Japanese. However, since Japanese has 3 scripts, one, the Kanji consisting of over 5000 characters, in all the courses conducted at the University, emphasis is on learning the script, reading and writing. Due to time constraints, very little emphasis is given to speaking. This course is for students who wish to improve their speaking skills.

- O 5861 Title of the Course
Diploma in Conversational Japanese
- O 5862 Eligibility: Students seeking admission to the One Year Course in Conversational Japanese should have passed Level 3 of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test conducted each year all over the world by the Japan Foundation (Government of Japan), and may be given admission after they have undergone an entrance test and have been found suitable. The entrance test consisting of 2 papers as under shall be administered.
(i) An essay paper in the subject. (ii) A paper to test the student's general acquaintance with the subject. (iii) An interview.
- R 8026 Intake capacity : 20
- R 8027 Teaching faculty qualification: as per University regulations.
- R 8028 Duration of the course
The Diploma in Conversational Japanese will be of one academic year.
- R 8029 Fee Structure: as per University regulations
- R 8030 Scheme of Syllabus and Evaluation for the One Year Conversational Course in Japanese
Text Book: The main text books used will be Minna no Nihongo 2. 2007. (Published by the Three A Network, Japan) and Japanese through Dialogues for Intermediate Learners (Drills and Tasks) published by The Japan Times, Japan.

Additional material from newspapers and magazines and the internet will also be used.

Exam Pattern: There will be viva of 100 marks consisting of:

1. Aural Comprehension	25 marks
2. Dictation	20 marks
3. Reading	20 marks
4. Questions based on reading	20 marks
5. General Conversation	<u>25 marks</u>
Total	100 marks
