

CIRCULAR: -

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabi relating to the One year Post-graduate Diploma course in Museology and Conservation vide this office Circular No. UG/400 of 2008, dated 26th August, 2008 and the Principals of affiliated colleges in Arts are hereby informed that recommendation made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Ancient Indian History Culture and Archaeology at its meeting held on 7th May, 2010 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 10th June, 2010 vide item No. 433 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 26th August, 2010 vide item No. 23 and that, in accordance therewith, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it under sub section (i) of Section 55 of the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994, it has amended Regulation 8277 relating to the examination and results for One year P.G. Diploma Course in Museology and Conservation to read as under and the same has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2009-2010.

1. Papers for the Semester I will be :

- I. Introduction to Museum, Museology and Museography.
- II. Museum Management.
- III. Collection Management.

2. Papers for the Semester II will be:

- I. Exhibition Planning and designing
- II. Care and Conservation of Museum Material.
- III. Museum Communication.

Regulation 8277 relating to the examination and results.

1. Results of the examination for the course will be declared by the University for Semester I and semester II, Result will be the consolidated result with grade Mentioned.
2. Each semester exam will be conducted once in a year.
3. Assessment for the practicals and assignments should be internal and the mark- sheet should be submitted to university by the concern College/ Institute before the commencement of the final theory examination of the particular semester.
4. Assessment of the dissertation also should be internal and the marks should be submitted to the University before the commencement of the Semester II theory examination.
5. No exemption should be given in any paper in any semester in any theory examination on any ground to the student as the theory paper is of 25 marks only.
6. In case of reappearing for the examination, assignment and practical marks should be carry forward.
7. Reappeared/repeater candidate should be given the lowest passing grade after the successful completion of the course.
8. Only three years validity should be given for the enrollment for the course to any candidate.
