POST-GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN PHILOSOPHY OF COMMUNAL HARMONY AND SOCIAL PEACE

R.5372:- Examination Pattern:-

Two final examinations for theory Papers I and II of 100 marks each. The theory question papers will consist of 4 questions (with the possibility of internal options) covering each unit and all the questions will be compulsory. One project of 100 marks. The project has to be completed under the guidance of a teacher who is recognized by the University of Mumbai or the IGNOU as a guide for the Ph.D. or a recognized Post-graduate teacher of University of Mumbai in any of the subjects disciplines related to the course. The list of guides for the project will be prepared by the University Department of Philosophy and not more than 5 students will registered under a single guide. The work on the project will be scheduled as under:-

Selection of Topic and Assignment: By 15th September of Guide Submission of the Project of the: Before 10th March Department

Presentation and Assessment of: 12th, 30th March Project
