Sir,

I am to invite your attention to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the Post-Graduate Diploma in Hospital Management and Health Care vide this office Circular No.UG/352 of 2004 dated 21st August, 2004 and to inform you that the proposal for modification in Internship and number of hours for Post-graduate Diploma in Hospital Management and Health Care conducted by your Institute has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 18th August, 2006 vide item No.7.5 and that in accordance therewith the modification for internship and number of hours as under:-

I INTERNSHIP:-

The syllabus has the following notes as a part of examination:

On completion of the Semester II and Semester III, student will two full time internships of minimum four (4) weeks each and certified by the institution where internship is taken up. Further there are no marks allotted for these.

For a part-time course in the evening, it would be impractical to expect the students, most of whom are working persons, to undergo full time internship for five weeks, Moreover, the two internships now required to be done by the students are not evaluated.

It was decided to replace these 2 full time internships with two part time internships of 4 weeks completing 100 hours each. These will be treated as two subjects with 75 marks each and evaluated based on report and viva.

II REDUCTION IN NUMBER OF HOURS:

Present syllabus has 288 hours of theory. For a part time course in the evenings, teaching of 288 hours in a Semester of 15 weeks means 17 hours per week i.e. 3.2 hours per day, which is not feasible.

Hence, it is proposed to cut down hours to 2 hours per day i.e. 12 hrs. per week and 30 hrs per subject.
