Attention of the Director, Mumbai University Institute of Chemical Technology, and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in Pharmacy is hereby invited to the Regulations relating to the Bachelor of Pharmaceutical Sciences (B.Pharm.) degree course vide Pamphlet No.187 and to this office Circular No.UG/451 of 2003 dated 16th September, 2003 and they are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Pharmaceutical Sciences at its meeting held on 24th March. 2005, has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 2nd April, 2005 vide item No.4.36 and subsequently approved by the Manangement Council at its meeting held on 16th April, 2005 vide item No.11 and that in accordance therewith Regulation 4379 relating to the Periodic Test for the B. Pharm. Science degree course has been amended to read as Under:-

R.4379: Periodic Test will be conducted for each semester by the Colleges/Institutions. The Periodic Test be held as per the examination scheme for each semester/s. Candidate remaining absent for the Periodic Test for any reason/s, whatsoever, will be treated as not appeared for the Periodic Test. The marks of the periodic Test conducted in the colleges/Institutions will be submitted to the Examination section before the commencement of the theory or practical examination whichever is earlier. If the student wishes to reappear for the Periodic Test, he/she shall be allowed to re-appear for the Periodic Test in various semester/s subject to the condition that he/she declared to have failed or A.T.K.T. of the examination/s.

Further that Regulation 4379 relating to the Periodic Test for the B.Pharm Sciences degree course has been brought into force with effect from the examination to be held in the first half of 2005.
