

CIRCULAR:-

Attention of the Deans, affiliated Medical Colleges and the Director, All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation is hereby invited to the Ordinances relating to the Ph.D. degree in Physiotherapy vide Pamphlet No.75 and to this office Circular No. UG 289 of 2004, dated 14th July, 2004 and they are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Research and Recognition committee for the Ad-hoc Committee in Physiotherapy under the Faculty of Medicine at its meeting held on 29th September, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 8th October, 2004 vide item No.4.12 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 29th October, 2004 vide item No.22 and that in accordance therewith the following new Ordinances have been passed for recognition of persons or teachers of the University for guiding students for Ph.D. in Physiotherapy :-

**ORDINANCES RELATING TO THE RECOGNITION OF
PERSONS AS TEACHERS OF THE UNIVERSITY FOR Ph.D. IN
PHYSIOTHERAPY**

O. 5467. Except in the case of persons with pre-eminent qualifications, recognition will ordinarily be granted only on application made in the prescribed format.

O.5468: Every application for recognition as a teacher of the University shall be made in writing in the form provided for the purpose by the University, and shall be submitted through the Head of the College or Recognized Institution in which the applicant is working.

O.5469 :-The Head of the College or Recognized Institutions, through whom the application is submitted and the applicant shall give such further information as may be required by the University in connection with the application of the candidate to be recognized as a teacher of the University.

O.5470 :-Teachers to be recognised for the Ph.D. degree in Physiotherapy must have a Ph.D. degree or equivalent in Physiotherapy or any branch of Health Sciences and research publications, which may include articles embodying the results of research or investigations, published in recognized journals (other than publications based on thesis submitted for any research degree to their credit in the subject of Physiotherapy) and ten years experience of having taught post-graduate classes, and successfully guided at least ten candidates for the Master's degree in Physiotherapy.

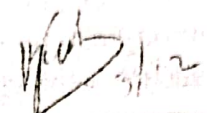
OR

A Master's degree in Physiotherapy with considerable research work of recognized merit to their credit in addition to publications, which may include articles embodying the results of research or investigations, published in recognized journals (other than publications based on thesis submitted for any research degree to their credit in the subject of Physiotherapy) and fifteen years experience of having taught post graduate classes, and successfully guided at least fifteen candidates for the Master's degree in Physiotherapy of this University.

Further that the aforesaid Ordinances have been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2004-2005

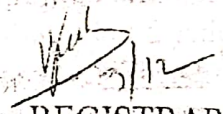
