

CIRCULAR :-

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm.) degree course *vide* Pamphlet No. 187 and to this Circular No.UG/451 of 2003 dated 16th September, 2003 and the Director, Mumbai University Institute of Chemical Technology and the Principals of the affiliated colleges of Pharmacy are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Pharmacy at its meeting held on 3rd August, 2007 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 10th August, 2007 *vide* item No. 4.26 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 16th August, 2007 *vide* item No.53 and that in accordance therewith, the Ordinance 5264 relating to the additional condition for the candidates who have entered into the course at Second Year B.Pharm. degree course (Semester III) level as per O.5261 under the old course is amended to read as under :-

"O.5264 : They must keep term for the following subject heads, hence forth referred as Remedial Subjects, of Semester-I and Semester-II. Accordingly the institutes must arrange the lecture schedules in the respective semesters such that these candidates can keep term for the subject heads. The institute will devise a mechanism to keep records by way of getting form filled by these candidate for attending the lectures, attendance records, etc. as is done to the regular candidates. However no additional fees will be charged by the institute.

The Remedial Subjects are as under :-

Semester	Subjects Heads
I	Organic Chemistry-I Physical Pharmacy-I Pharmaceutical Engineering-I
II	Physical Pharmacy-II Organic Chemistry-II

The candidates have to appear for examinations in the above subject heads and also the periodic test. The candidates will be charged separate examination fees. While filling the examination form it should be clearly stated that these candidates are appearing for the examination in the **Remedial Subjects**. These subjects and the result will be separately included under the heading Remedial Subjects in the mark list of Semester-III for the subject of Semester-II.

The candidate/s be allowed for Third Year B.Pharm. Course (Sem.V & Sem.VI), provided he/she should have passed Sem.III and IV or passed Sem.III and A.T.K.T. for Sem. IV or A.T.K.T. for Sem.III and passed Sem.IV or A.T.K.T. for Sem.III and A.T.K.T. for Sem.IV and failed in the Remedial Subjects of Sem.I and II.

Further that in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 54(1) of the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994, it has amended the **Ordinance 5264** relating to the additional condition for the candidates who have entered into the course at Second Year B. Pharm. degree course (Semester III) level as per O 5261 under the old course has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2007-2008.
