

CIRCULAR: -

A reference is invited to the Ordinance, Regulations and syllabi relating to the T.Y.B.A degree course vide this office circular No.UG./208 of 2007, dated 18th May, 2007 and the Principals of affiliated colleges in Arts and Professor-cum Director, Institute of Distance and Open Learning are hereby informed that the report of the Sub- Committee and ex- members of Board of Studies in English Literature at its meeting held on 15th September, 2010 has been accepted by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under section 14 (7) of the Maharashtra University Act, 1994 on behalf of the Academic Council and that in accordance therewith the matter was discussed at length by the members at the meeting and the following decision were taken :-

1. It was resolved that, Rohinton Mistry's novel "Such a Long Journey" prescribed as an optional text in S.Y.B.A. English Literature Paper III be withdrawn with immediate effect
2. It was also resolved that if the said text had been taught in any of the colleges of the University, the term exam for Paper III (Regular & ATKT) be postponed by at least a month in such colleges.

Further "Resolved that No question should be set for the term and ATKT Examinations on Rohinton Mistry's novel, "Such A Long Journey," instead an additional question on the background topics should be asked. Thereby there should be one background question on the novel and one background question on poetry should be given. **This recommendation does not apply to those colleges where the above text is not taught.**"
