CIRCULAR :

Attention of Principals of the affiliated colleges in the faculty of Arts and Professor cum-Director, Institute of Distance Education is hereby invited to the scheme of papers relating to the B.A. degree course under the revised pattern vide pamphlet No.150 and to this office Circular No.UG/229 of 2003 dated 4th June, 2003 and they are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Board of Studies in Economics at its meeting held on 20th December, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 5th February, 2005 vide item No.4.1 and that in accordance therewith the pattern of question paper in the subject of Economics at the T.Y.B.A. examination is as follows :-

"For a paper of 100 marks there would be two sections with four questions each carrying equal marks and the students would be permitted to attempt five questions selecting not more than three questions from any one section. All the answers to the questions shall be written in one and the same answer-book. Similarly, for a paper of 80 marks, there would be no sections with seven questions and the students would be permitted to attempt any four questions."

Further the aforesaid pattern of question paper will be brought into force with effect from the academic year 2005-2006.
