## Pattern of Question Paper to be brought into effect from March 2008

80 marks, Duration 2 1/2 hours for Regular students; 100 marks, Duration 3 nours for IDE students.

There will be 3 Sections in the paper.

There will and II have 40 marks each. Regular students have to attempt questions only Sections I and II. from Sections I and II.

from Section III has 20 marks. IDE students have to attempt questions from all the 3 Sections.

There will be 3 questions in Section I and 3 questions in Section II. Any 2 out of the 3 There will all a questions in Section questions from each Section, 4 questions in all, are to be attempted.

All the 6 questions carry 20 marks each.

Q. No. 1 in Section I and Q. No.4 in Section II will be -

Write any 4 Short Notes out of 6, Or Answer any 4 short questions out of 6, each for 5 marks. Q. No. 1 and Q. No. 4 will be based on 2 different topics within the respective Section, with 3 Short Notes/Short Questions from each of the 2 topics. The combination of these 2 topics will change across the 3 sets of Question papers within a year as shown in the table below.

Q. 2 and 3 in Section I, and Q. 5 and 6 in Section II will be full-length, essay-type.

Out of the 4 topics in each section, the Questions on Topic II in Section 1 -'Understanding Performance' and on Topic VIII in Section II - 'The Organization of Work Behaviour' will be full-length, essay-type.

The other full-length essay-type question in each Section will be on the remaining one topic within the respective Section, which is not covered in Q. No. 1 and Q. No. 4.
