A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabus relating to the T.Y.B.Com. degree course vide Pamphlet No.152 and to this office Circular No.UG/191 of 2009, dated 4th June, 2009 and the Principals of the affiliated Colleges in Commerce and the Professor-cum-Director, Institute of Distance and Open Learning are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Faculty of Commerce at its meeting held on 16th February, 2010 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 3rd March, 2010 vide item No. 4.12 and that, in accordance therewith, that the Question Paper Pattern of T.Y.B.Com. Computer System and Application (Applied Component) has been brought into force with effect from the examination to be held from 1st half of the academic year 2010.

All questions will have internal option as follows.

All questions will have 3 sub-questions (a), (b), (c) each carrying 8 marks and students will be asked to answer any two sub-questions out of 3.

The instructions at the start of the question paper will be as follows:

- (1) All questions carry equal marks and are compulsory.
- (2) Attempt any-two sub-questions out of three sub-questions in each question.
- (3) Attempt either Q.4 on Visual Basic or Q.4 on C Language.
- (4) Figures to the right indicate maximum marks for a question.

Q. 1 will be based on Unit-I

Q. 2 will be based on Unit-II

Q. 3 will be based on Unit-III

Distribution of marks for Q.1, Q.2 and Q.3 will be as follows:

- (a) 4+4 marks
- (b) 4+4 marks
- (c) 4+4 marks

Distribution of marks for Q.4 on Visual Basic and Q.4 on C language will be as follows

- (a) 4+4 marks
- (b) 4+4 marks
- (c) 2+6 marks

Distribution of marks for Q.5 on Excel/Spreadsheet will be as follows

- (a) 2+6 marks
- (b) 2+6 marks
- (c) 2+6 marks

The total marks for true and false in Q.1 and Q.2 should be subjective question of 4 marks.
