- If the candidate has passed S.Y.J.C. with German as one of the papers or
- If the candidate has learnt German in school for at least 2 years.

R 5551 Duration = 8 Weeks (2 months)

120 hrs. total = 4 credits

3 hrs. per day (from Monday to Friday)

15 hrs. per week

R 5552 Course Structure : 4 times a year i.e. July & August
September & October
December & January
February & March

R 5553 The following is the scheme of the examination and syllabus for the course -
There shall be a written as well as oral examination.

Written Test will be of 100 marks and 3 hrs. duration
