

CIRCULAR:-

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and Syllabi relating to the degree of Master of Library Science *vide* Pamphlet No.9 and to this office Circular No.UG/358 of 2002, dated 27th August,2002 and the Head, University Department of Library and Information Science, the Principal of the affiliated colleges in the Faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce and the Assistant Registrar, Sub-Centre, Ratnagiri are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Library and Information Science at its meeting held on 5th August,2006 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 18th August,2006 *vide* Item No. 4.41 and that in accordance therewith, the following changes have been made in the Group-B-2-Project Report, Presentation and viva-voce at the M.L.I.Sc. Science degree course and that the same has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2006-2007:-

1. Project Report 100 marks

The topic of the Project Report shall be submitted alongwith a synopsis in triplicate not exceeding 1000 words, for approval by the Departmental Committee comprising of following members :-

- (1) Chairman –Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Library and Information Science
- (2) Head – Department of Library and Information Science, University of Mumbai.
- (3) Adjunct/visiting faculty member

Each student shall work under the guidance of a recognized University teacher for his/her Project Report and shall submit TWO COPIES of the same at least TWO MONTHS prior to date of commencement of the theory examination.

2. Presentation of Project Report 50 Marks

The Presentation of Project Report by each student shall be centrally organized by the Department of Library and Information Science- University of Mumbai on a predetermined day and will be centrally assessed and evaluated by the examiners comprising of one Internal and one External examiner from amongst the panel of examiners.

3. Viva Voce 50 Marks

On presentation of project report, each student will be orally and centrally examined by the same panel of examiners which has assessed and evaluated the project presentation with the objective of testing the candidates knowledge of Library and Information Science in general .
