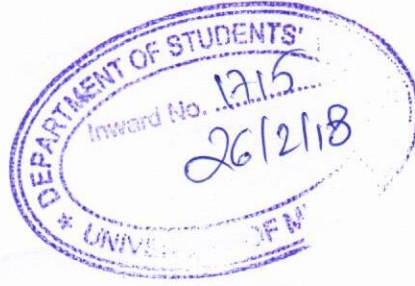

Dear Madam/Sir,

I have the pleasure to inform you that the Embassy of Japan in India has just started the Application process for the 2018 Japan Exchange and Teaching Programme (JET Programme).

The JET Programme is implemented by local authorities and other organisations who appoint participants in cooperation with the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications (MIC), the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA), the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT), and the Council of Local Authorities for International Relations (CLAIR), Japan.

The JET Programme offers highly qualified college/university graduates opportunities to work as either Assistant Language Teachers (ALT) or Coordinators for International Relations (CIR) in selected local government offices in Japan, and aims to enhance foreign language education and promote international exchange at the local level through the fostering of ties between Japanese youth and foreign youth alike.

This year, the total number of openings available to Indian candidates is 2 (two) CIRs. One CIR, who is either from the State of Kerala by birth or has lived/is living in the State of Kerala, is to be placed in Matsue City, Shimane Prefecture. The other CIR is to be placed in Okuizumo Town, Shimane Prefecture (there is no restriction regarding birthplace or residential state, the only condition being that the applicant must have an Indian Nationality).
