Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter-University Elocution Competition in English 2018-19

PREAMBLE (Rules of the Competition)

- The Competition will be open to all Students, both Under-Graduate and Post-Graduate of Agricultural and Non-agricultural Universities in the State of Maharashtra.
- 2. Procedure for selecting students for the Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter-University Elocution Competition in English will be as follows:
 - Every University will conduct Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter-Collegiate Elocution Competition in English at its own end by inviting only one student from each college affiliated to the University. This will be a semi-final round of the competition and will be completed before end of September 29, 2018.
 - Select one winner from amongst those participants in the competition and nominate him/her for the final round to be organized at the University of Mumbai.
 - There will be five topics for the Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter-Collegiate Elocution Competition and any one of them will be given to a participant half an hour before actual commencement of the competition.
 - Every participant will be given 5 (Five) minutes at the semi-final round and a warming bell will be given after 4 (Four) minutes.
 - All expenses such as travel, lodging, boarding etc. of the participant for the semi-final round will have to be borne by the respective colleges.
- The student secured First Rank in the Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter-Collegiate Elocution Competition in English of the respective University is allowed to participate in P.C. Alexander Inter-University Elocution Competition in English.
- All expenses such as travel, lodging, boarding etc. of the participant for the Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter-Collegiate Elocution Competition in English (Final Round) will have to be borne by the respective Universities.
- There will be five topics for the Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter-Collegiate Elocution Competition in English and any one of them will be given to a participant half an hour before actual commencement of the competition.
- 6. Every participant will be given 7 (Seven) minutes at the semi-final round and a warming bell will be given after 5 (Five) minutes.
- 7. Order of the participants will be arranged alphabetically.
- 8. The Vice-Chancellor from University of Mumbai will nominate three judges for Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter-Collegiate Elocution Competition in English (Final Round)
- 9. Decision of the Panel of Judges will be final and binding to all the participants.
- 10. At the final round two winners will be selected. The first winner and the second winner will be given the cash prizes of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) and Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two thousand only), respectively, along with a Certificate of Merit. The Cash Prizes and Certificate of Merit will be distributed at the time of Convocation of the University of Mumbai. The date, time and venue of the Convocation Ceremony will be communicated to both the winners personally through phone call and email.
- 11. Certificate of the Participation will be distributed to all the participating students on the day of competition (i.e. Saturday, October 6, 2018).
