6	Zone VI	Thane and Palghar Tribal	(Talukas: Shahapur, Murbad, Wada, Vikramgadh, Jawhar, Mokhada and Talasari)
7	Zone VII	Raigad North	(Talukas : Panvel, Uran, Khalapur and Karjat)
8	Zone VIII	Raigad South	(Talukas : Alibaug, Pen, Sudhagad, Roha, Tala, Mangaon, Murud, Shrivardhan, Mhasle, Mahad and Poladpur)
9	Zone IX	Ratnagiri North	(Talukas : Mandangad, Dapoli, Khed, Guhagar and Chiplun)
10	Zone X	Ratnagiri South	(Talukas : Ratnagiri, Sangameshwar, Lanja and Rajapur)

(1) District/Zonal Inter Collegiate Cultural Youth Festival

At Zone I to IV, The festival may be organised at two different colleges where one college will host events of PERFORMING ARTS and other college will host events of FINE ART AND LITERARY. However one college may host events of PERFORMING ARTS and FINE ART AND LITERARY separately on two different days.

At zone V to XI all events will be organised at one centre and on same day only.

The following infrastructure is desirable to host one of the activities in your college:

Infrastructure for Cultural Youth Festival:

For Theatre Section Hall or Auditorium with a stage, sound system and

proper seating arrangements (Four Venues)

For Dance Section Hall or Auditorium/Bigger Classroom (Two Venues)

For Music Section Hall or Classrooms with arrangements of sound system

(Four Venues)

For Literary Section Two Hall or Classrooms

For Fine Arts Section Two Halls or Gymkhana or Library/ Laboratories (Three Halls)

Notes:

- Boarding facilities should be available so as to provide food for participants at their own cost.
- Judges for the competition will be appointed by the Department of Students' Development for all centres.
- Expenses on make-up/special light effects/special sound effects, etc. will be borne by the participant colleges.
- The arrangement of papers, clay, magazines for collage and other materials (except colours) will be made available by the Department of Students' Development for Fine Art Competitions.

(2) Workshops for Cultural Youth Festival:

Colleges are requested to make the arrangements for audio visual arrangements and one big hall and auditorium. The expenses will be shared by the department for the workshops. Lodging and boarding arrangements will have to be made by the College.

The college may apply on or before 8th June, 2017.
