The CoHaB IDC is the second phase of the Diasporic Construction of Home and Belonging CoHaB programme at the University of Mumbai. It was initiated in 2012 and has since earned a global reputation of being an academically high valued research and resource centre. The Centre has gained an excellent status by guiding and producing scholars in the field of Global Diaspora Studies, Ethnicity, Migration, and Identity issues.

Professor Nilufer E.Bharucha, is the CoHaB IDC Director and Scientist-in-Charge at Mumbai University and Professor Klaus Stierstorfer, University of Muenster is the overall Coordinator of the programme. The Centre also has connections with various partner Universities such as the Muenster University, Germany, the Stockholm University, Sweden and the SOAS, Oxford and Northampton Universities in the U.K. CoHaB has on its advisory board internationally acclaimed scholars such as Avtar Brah and Homi Bhabha.



The centre has conducted a summer school on diaspora studies and organised an international conference. It also regularly invites research scholars from all across the nation and globe for workshops, talks and seminars.

The centre has a collection of books, critical materials and DVDs on the concept of Diaspora. The Centre holds film viewing sessions, talks, workshops and lectures regularly.
