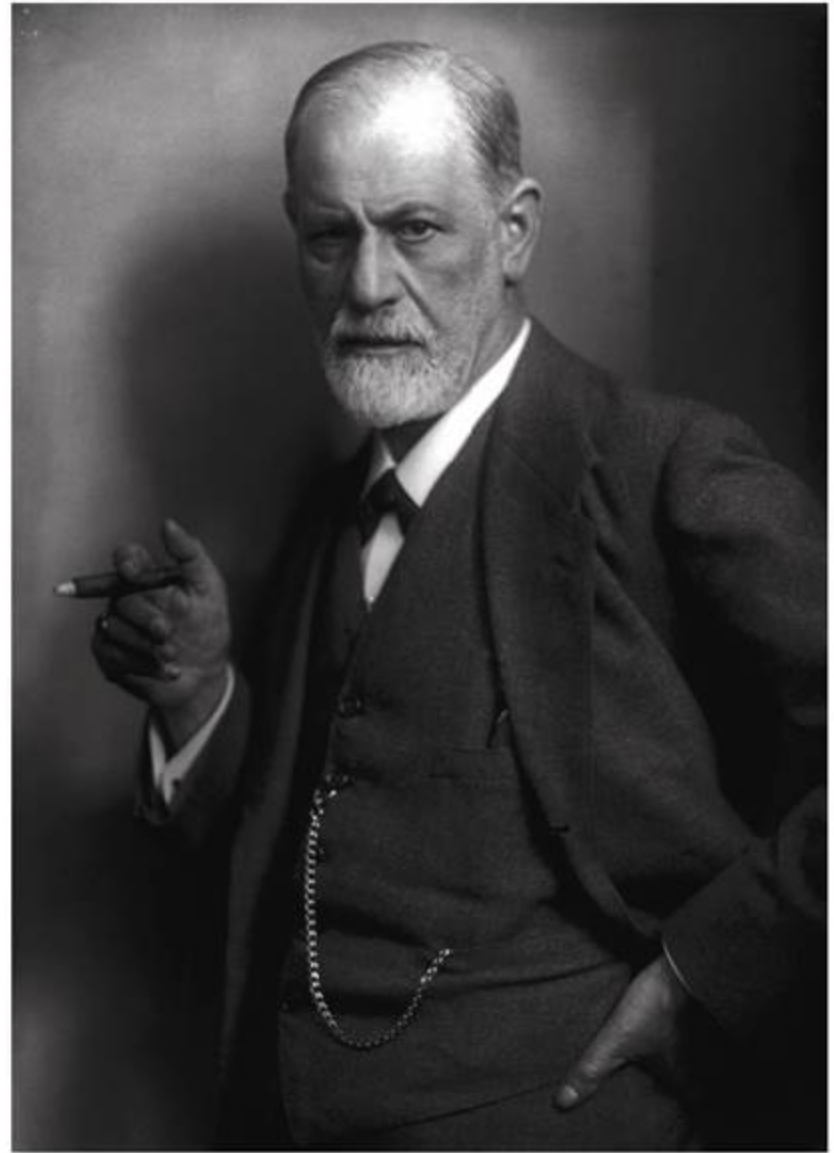
SIGMUND FREUD
