1. Applications must be complete in all respects and must be submitted to the Head, Department of Civics and Politics, University of Mumbai, Vidyanagri, Santacruz (E), Mumbai-400 098.
2. A list of students who are selected for admission to the Post-Graduate Diploma Course in International Studies will be exhibited on the Notice Board of the University Department of Civics and Politics.
3. Students selected for admission are required to enroll themselves in the University Department of Civics and Politics and to have their names registered with University through the Department within a week from the date of notification of the names of the selected applicants.
4. Applicants are requested to inform the office of the University Department of Civics and Politics within a week from the date of publication of the list of selected candidates, in case they do not wish to avail themselves of the seats offered, so as to enable the Department to allot the vacant seats to the students on the waiting list. Seats of students who fail to enroll themselves within the period of one week will be allotted to others on the waiting list.
5. Candidates who are graduates of Universities other than the University of Mumbai are required to obtain a Certificate of Eligibility from the Registrar, University of Mumbai before they can be admitted to the Department.
6. Applications must be accompanied by certified copies of the degree certificate.
