In case, in the opinion of the Head of University Department or the Principals of the recognized Post-graduate Institutions concerned, the candidate has not satisfactorily carried out the assigned work as mentioned above, they may not grant term to the student, even though he/she might have kept the minimum attendance at the lectures.
