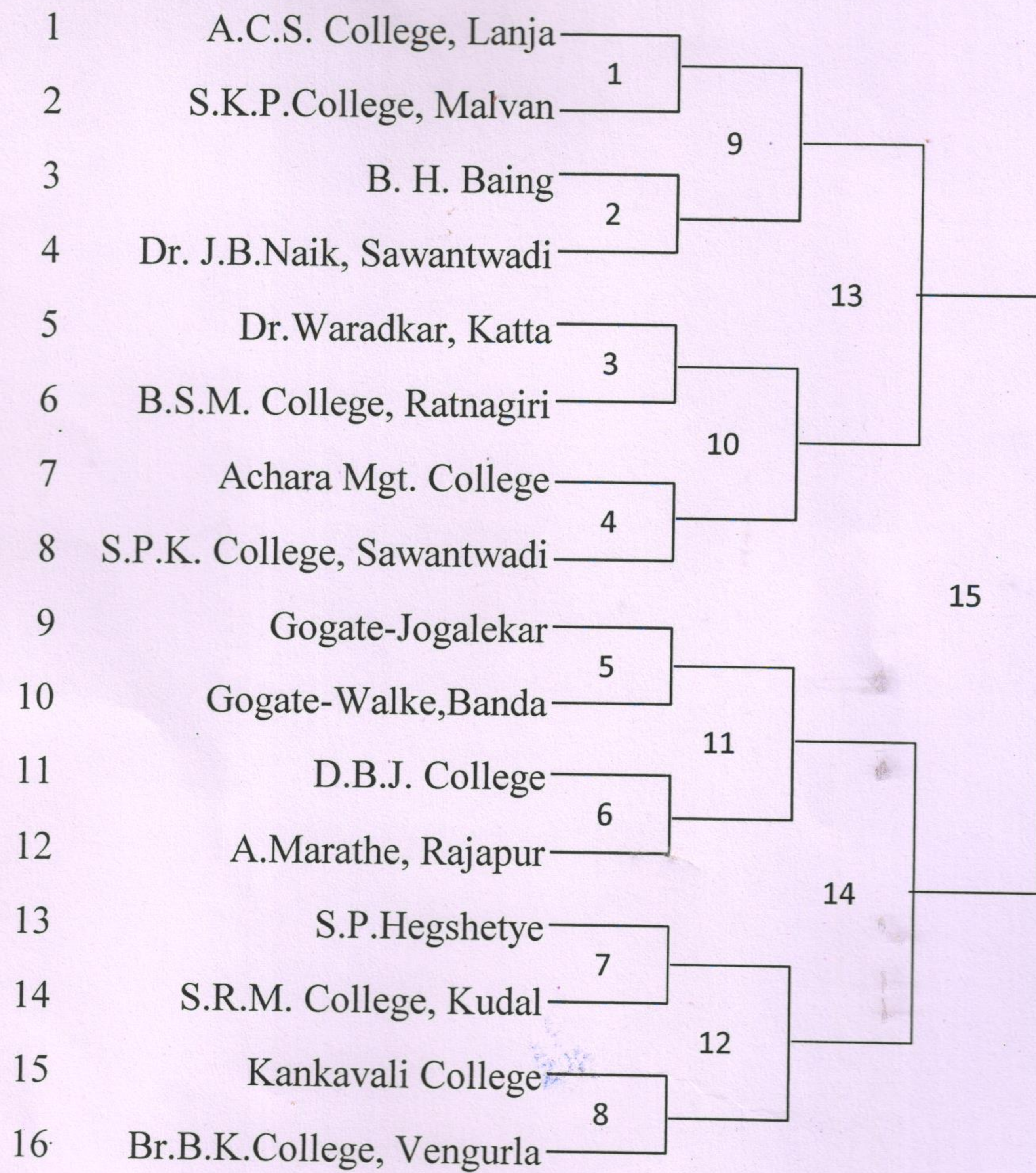

Instructions:-

The following guidelines and instructions have been issued by the University for the smooth conduct of the tournaments. It is absolutely necessary that the instructions are scrupulously followed by the participating Colleges.

1. Maintenance of Discipline:

In order to maintain the law and discipline during the tournament game, it is necessary that a senior staff member of college is deputed to be in-charge of the college team. He should insure that the students of his college maintain strict discipline and behave in manner which would obviate the possibility of any complaint being received from the club authorities on whose ground, the match is staged.

2. Ground charges, Use of Cricket Balls & Umpiring Charges if any:

The Contesting teams have to bear the **expenses including on ground charges, use of Cricket Balls & Umpiring Charges, Scorers, etc. of Rs.1,500/- per match per team** during their tournament games. The Cricket ball will be provided at the time of competition.

3. Rules for the conduct of Tournament:

The matches in this tournaments will be governed by the said rules. The some major rules as follows:

1. Matches will be played on T-20 format as per M.C.A. standard Rule.
2. A Bowler can bowl maximum five overs only.
3. The Inter-Collegiate Cricket match will be of 20 overs. Each team will have to bowl maximum 20 overs in an inning within 1.30 hrs.
4. Over rate shall be 14 overs per hour of play.
5. If the run record are same then team which has higher runs scored per over shall be the Winner. In case run rate being equal the Winner will be declared by spin of coin.
5. No Postponement will be given.
6. Hours of play:



7. The team should report to the Tournament Secretary for the game at least 15 Minutes prior to the commencement of the game.
9. The Management reserves the right to change the programme of fixture as and when it deems necessary.
10. The team is not ready to start the game within 30 minutes of the time scheduled for play the opposite team may given a walk-over.

11. Teams must accompany with their college Sports Director/Sports In charge otherwise team will not allow to take part in Inter-Collegiate Cricket Matches.
12. College Identity Card of current academic year is compulsory.
13. All Teams should report on time with a copy of the Entry/Eligibility proforma with required documents mention in the circular No.SP./06 of 2019-20 of dated 17th July, 2019 for verification purpose are compulsory.
14. The expenses on the TA/DA of the participants/team manager will have to be borne by the respective colleges.
