- 1. One college/institute/university department shall send one entry.
- 2. The number of student participants should not be less than 5 and more than 20.
- 3. The age of the student should not be more than 25 years as on September 30, 2020.
- 4. The lyrics of the song is attached along with this circular and participating student has to compose the music on the given lyrics and prepare an audiovisual song.
- 5. Participating college/institute/university department should separately compose the music. The music should be unique and fresh. The song must be prepared by following all rules and regulations set by the government from time to time regarding the COVID-19.
- 6. Participants may use any electronic/digital device/s for preparation of song.
- 7. Singers and artists in the visuals must be bonafide students of the college/institute/university department. However, they can take the help of alumni/professionals for music composing, choreography, cinematography, editing and direction. The footage of any related situation/s can be used with concern permissions.
- 8. The time duration of the song is maximum 5 minutes.
