(M.A. Philosophy Part-I: Semester-I)

The Department of Philosophy, University of Mumbai invites online applications for its M.A. programme for the Academic Year 2020-21.

Important Dates (Revised):

- Admission open: November 27, 2020
- Last date for filling online admission forms: December 10, 2020
- Display of First Merit List: December 21, 2020
- Online fee payment (for First Merit List): to be announced
- Second merit list (entrance exam students) December 27, 2020
- The second merit list will be sent to PG Section for approval.
- Online fee payment (for Second Merit List): date will be announced after approval from the PG Section
- Students from other Universities require provisional eligibility from the Eligibility Section (fee payment date will be announced accordingly)
- Commencement of Semester I classes: January, 2021

Applicants are requested to take additional note of the following :

1. Student should select M.A. Regular-CBCS Department of Philosophy M.A. Part-I, Semester -I to fill Application for Admission to Mumbai University Department (on program selection screen).
2. Applicants (with an undergraduate degree) seeking admission to M.A philosophy should have at least S.Y.B.A in philosophy to appear on the first merit list.
3. Reservations are applicable as per State Government and University Guidelines.
4. Submission of "non-creamy layer certificate" (for the financial year 2019-2020) is compulsory for reserved category applicants (except SC/ST applicants).
5. Applicants have to upload documents by using the "add upload" button option.
6. Applicants have to upload a high resolution of scanned documents for visibility
7. Applications will be rejected if uploaded scanned copies are not readable.
8. Merit List will be prepared as follows (i) First Merit List of applicants with minimum S.Y.B.A philosophy (and a B.A degree) (ii) Second Merit List of applicants with graduation in subjects other than philosophy (and without minimum S.Y.B.A in philosophy at the undergraduate level) who have given entrance exams
9. 3% seats are reserved for students from other universities (subject to the eligibility requirements of the University of Mumbai).
