The Heads of the University Departments / the Principals of the Affiliated/Constituent Colleges in Arts & Science and the Coordinator / Assistant Registrar, University Sub Center at Ratnagiri, are hereby notified as under:-

- 5 The **Heads**, Co-ordinator, Ratnagiri sub-centre in Science subjects will complete the admission procedure of M.Sc. (Part I) strictly on merit basis only by following the reservations norms as prescribed by the Government of Maharashtra and University from time to time.
- 6 Every Students must fill the Pre Admission online Registration Form on the Mumbai University portal (www.mum.digitaluniversity.ac)
- 7 All the Principals of the **Colleges** having the courses for **M.Sc. on unaided basis (including Physics) except Botany, and Zoology, Microbiology** will complete the admission procedure strictly on merit basis by following the reservations norms as prescribed by the University of Mumbai from time to time.
- 8 Online Admissions to the M.Sc. degree courses in the **subjects of Physics (Aided) and Botany, Zoology, Microbiology (Aided & Unaided)** for the Academic Year 2020 - 2021 will be made by the P. G. Admission Enrolment, Eligibility & Migration Department, University of Mumbai.

The criteria to be taken into consideration for merit list for University online admissions and college admissions will be as follows in order of preference :-

1) For Mumbai University Students :

- f) The students who have been declared successful in and above without grace marks with as a single major subject out of 1200 (Sem V & VI).
- g) The CGPA will be considered, if the marks are equal.
- h) In case there is a tie in a), b) c) aggregate marks without grace marks out of 1200. (Sem V & VI) preference will be given on the basis of Theory Marks.
- i) In case there is a tie in a), b), c) then marks in theory out of 800 without grace marks. (Sem V & VI) preference will be given on the total CGPA.
- j) The rules formulated by the Board of University Teaching & Research (Arts & Science) in 1962 Executive Council dated 7th September, 1987 governing the online admission process for the M.Sc Part- I course in the University of Mumbai mention Rule (vii) of the said Rules which states:-

“That seats which may fall vacant on account of any students failing to avail himself of the admission offered to him shall be filled in by students next in order of merit on the waiting list.”

There will be one common merit list for all the students in each subject for the online admissions to be made by the P. G. Admission Enrolment, Eligibility & Migration Department of the University of Mumbai. The final merit list will be displayed on the University website www.mu.ac.in (Home page will be open-> click on Sections Revised Structure of Sections-> Admission, Enrolment, Eligibility & Migration Department (AEM)). The merit list will also be mailed to the Colleges; provided mail address is communicated to the University.
