**ADMISSION SCHEDULE FOR THE SECOND SPOT ROUND FOR THE M. Sc.
DEGREE COURSE IN CHEMISTRY**

The students of University of Mumbai and Other University who have submitted their application forms for seeking admission to the Choice-based Credit System (CBCS) four Semesters M. Sc. degree course in Chemistry are hereby informed that the **Offline Second Spot Round** of admissions will be conducted by the Department on **Wednesday 10th February, 2021 at 11.00 a.m.**

The students *from all categories* who have already filled the forms, but have not been allotted any seat in the earlier rounds will be considered in the Second Spot Round on the merit basis. The students who have not paid the fees or cancelled the allotted seat in earlier rounds will not be considered for the Second Spot Round.

IN CASE OF THE NON AVAILABILITY OF CANDIDATE BELONGING TO RESERVED CATEGORY, THE SEAT WILL BE ALLOTTED TO GENERAL CATEGORY CANDIDATE.

IN CASE OF THE NON AVAILABILITY OF CANDIDATES OF UNIVERSITY OF MUMBAI, THE SEATS WILL BE ALLOTTED TO CANDIDATES OF OTHER UNIVERSITY.

The applicants present Physically in person for the Spot Round at 11.00 a.m. in the Department Office only will be considered for allotment of seats failing which the candidate will forfeit the claim for admission.

Applicant who has been allotted a seat in the Second Spot round is required to follow the following procedure strictly to confirm the admission.

1. The candidate will be issued four copies of the challan for payment of the prescribed fees (**For General Category: Rs. 11,145/- and for Reserved Category: Rs. 1295/-**) in Allahabad Bank, Kalina Branch, Wadia High School compound, Ground Floor, Opposite Vidyanagari Campus. **The candidate should pay the prescribed fees in the bank on the same day. Two copies of the duly stamped Challan would be returned to the student by the bank.**
2. One copy of the Challan should be preserved carefully by the candidate and **the other copy (Department copy) should be returned to the Department office on or before Thursday 11th February, 2021,** failing which the candidate will forfeit the claim for admission.
3. All the candidates are also required to pay **refundable deposit of Rs. 800 in cash at the Department Office.** A separate receipt would be given to the candidate which should be preserved carefully.
4. The student have to submit the original Statement of Marks and photocopy of T. Y. B. Sc. Examination for Mumbai University Students (Semester V and VI) for Other University students (Semester I to VI) to the Department office at the time of Admission only.
5. In case of reserved category students, submit the photo copy of caste certificate and the original caste certificate and its validity should be brought for verification.
6. In case of OBC/SBC/NT/DT candidates, a photo copy of Non-creamy Layer certificate of current financial year 2020-2021 should be submitted along with the caste certificate.
7. The students from EWS category have to submit a photo copy of EWS certificate for current financial year 2020-2021.
8. If the candidate fails to submit the required documents/certificates in the Department office at the time of Admission and paying the admission fees, he/she will forfeit the claim for the admission.

The candidates admitted in the Second Spot round should note that the admission process is considered to be complete only when the candidate completes all the formalities mentioned in points 1 to 8.
