**Alessandro Ferrara**, one of the most prominent political philosophers, has contributed to conceptualising democracy, egalitarianism, exemplarity and pluralism as key constituents of critical theory. He argues for a non-foundationalist normative perspective in the “lineage of authenticity” rather than the “tradition of autonomy”. He is the author of several books spanning *Reflective Authenticity: Rethinking the Project of Modernity* (1998), *Justice and Judgment: The Rise and the Prospect of the Judgment Model in Contemporary Political Philosophy* (1999), *The Force of the Example: Explorations in the Paradigm of Judgment* (2008), *The Democratic Horizon: Hyperpluralism and the Renewal of Political Liberalism* (2014), and *Rousseau and Critical Theory* (2017).
