University of Mumbai has been using MOODLE Learning Management System for the past 12 years. Use of Moodle was restricted to IDOL initially but now is being adopted by many more departments. The IQAC of University of Mumbai has conducted two online FDP and Workshops on Moodle for the University of Mumbai's Kalina, Thane, Ratnagiri and Fort campus/sub-centre teachers in May & June, 2020. 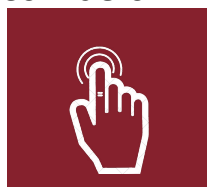

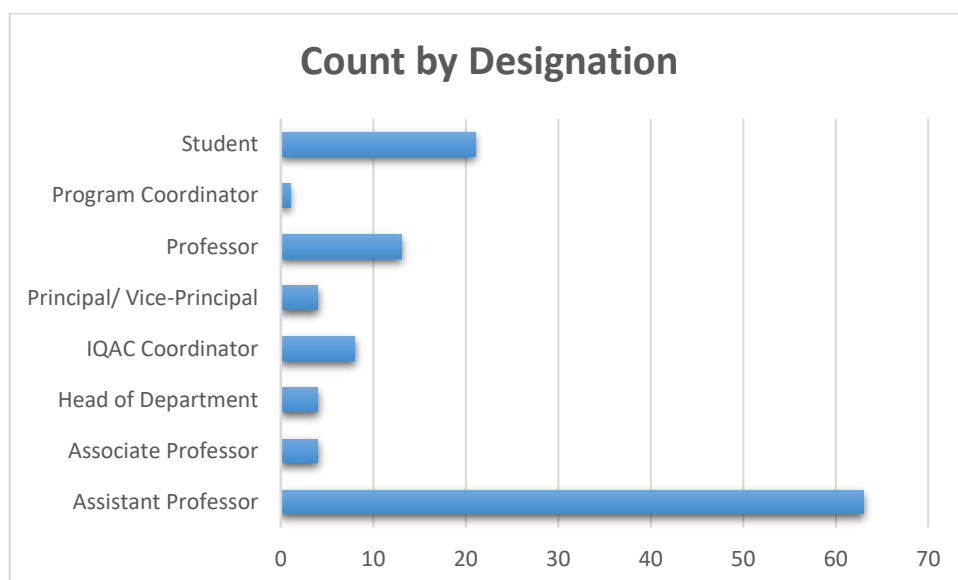
